

## SAMPLE CONFIRMATION LETTER

Instructions for use:

As with any gift, it is appropriate to acknowledge the donor and their intention to leave a legacy gift through a letter and / or call from a staff or board member.

Additionally, people who include an organization in their estate plans will often increase giving throughout their lifetime. Continue to steward these donors and provide them with regular updates on the organization's work and the opportunities to further your efforts now.
